Registration:

The registration fee per family will be \$25.00. This fee is non-refundable. Once registered, it is assumed the child will be a regular participant each week.

Tuition:

The fee for summer camp is \$210 for one child, \$380 for two children, \$575 for three children. Tuition is due at the beginning of the session.

Arrival and Dismissal:

The WEE Summer Camp is open on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Center doors are unlocked at 8:55 a.m. Drop off continues until 9:10 a.m. Doors are locked at 9:15 a.m. for safety purposes and to begin our school day. K3 & K4 students are dropped off in their respective car loops and walk independently to their classroom. Children 2 and younger are walked to the outside classroom door by the parent and dropped off there beginning at 8:55 a.m.

Center doors are unlocked at 12:45 p.m. Pick up begins at 12:45 p.m. K3 & K4 students are picked up in their respective car loops and placed in the car by our staff. We ask that you pull forward and to buckle. This keeps the car loop moving efficiently. Children 2 & younger are picked up from their outside classroom door.

For drop off and pick up of more than 1 child, please refer to our Parent Handbook for further instructions.

After one warning, a late fee of \$1.00 per minute is assessed after 1:05 pm.

Snacks and Lunch:

A mid-morning snack, consisting of water and goldfish, will be served to each child. If you do not wish for your child to have this snack, please send a snack with them.

Each child is asked to bring a lunch, with a drink. Make sure everything is marked clearly with the child's name. If you send fruit that needs to be peeled or cut-up (apples, oranges), please pack it ready to eat. For toddlers and twos, please send finger food or sandwiches. Please make sure your child has been fed his breakfast before arrival.

Purpose:

To provide a ministry to parents & young children in our church and community by:

- ☺ Providing a weekly break from parenting responsibilities.
- ☺ Giving the child responsible Christian education, care and guidance.
- ☺ Allowing the child to learn & socialize with others his/her own age & ability.

Ages:

- ☺ Available for children ages 2 months through rising K5.



Illness:

Parents are asked not to bring sick children to school. For the protection of your child and other children, parents are requested not to bring a child who appears ill. Upon the recommendation of the Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the American Academy of Pediatrics, a child should not be taken from home when any of the following exists:

- a. Fever - currently or within previous 24 hours.
- b. Vomiting or diarrhea - within previous 24 hours.
- c. Any symptom of a childhood disease such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox or whooping cough.
- d. Common cold - from onset through one week.
- e. Green runny nose.
- f. Sore throat.
- g. Croup.
- h. Any unexplained rash.
- i. Any skin infection - boils, ringworm, impetigo.
- j. Pink eye or other eye infection.

Emergency:

In the event of an emergency, the parents will be notified immediately.

Clothing and Diapers:

Parents are asked to bring: 1) 4 disposable diapers, 2) a change of clothing - please label all clothing, 3) baby wipes, and 4) a bib for babies and toddlers. Please, **NO PULLUPS**. Make sure clothing is appropriate for play. For babies, let your little one wear clothing with snaps for easier diaper changes, if possible. Have your child dressed for the day when he arrives. Please do not ask the teacher to change him out of his pajamas. Children are not to bring toys from home unless it is a security item.
