Registration/Materials fees & Tuition:

The registration fee is \$50.00 per family. This fee is non-refundable. Once registered, it is assumed the child will be a regular participant each week. Registration fee and any applicable materials fee is required to guarantee placement. Tuition is due on the first of each month, September through May. Tuition is not refunded for temporary absences or illness.

Arrival and Dismissal:

Center doors are unlocked at 8:55 am. Drop off continues until 9:10 a.m. Doors are locked at 9:15 am for safety purposes and to begin our school day. K3 & K4 students are dropped off in their respective car loops and walk independently to their classroom. Children 2 and younger are walked to the outside classroom door by the parent and dropped off there beginning at 8:55 a.m.

Center doors are unlocked at 12:45 p.m. Pick up begins at 12:45 p.m. K3 & K4 students are picked up in their respective car loops and placed in the car by our staff. We ask that you pull forward and to buckle. This keeps the car loop moving efficiently. Children 2 & younger are picked up from their outside classroom door.

For drop off and pick up of more than one child, please refer to our Parent Handbook for further instructions.

After one warning, a late fee of \$1.00 per minute is assessed after 1:05 pm.

Purpose:

- ☺ The WEE Program at Rock Springs is designed to support the home and extend the ministry of the church by providing biblically-based, age appropriate education for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers.
- ☺ Our purpose is to provide a loving Christian atmosphere that will promote the spiritual, intellectual, physical, social, and emotional development of each child.
- ☺ We provide a loving environment that fosters his self-esteem and independence. When your child leaves our program he should feel good about himself and be confident in a school setting.



Snacks and Lunches:

A mid-morning snack, consisting of water and goldfish, will be served to each child. If you do not wish for your child to have this snack, please send a snack with them.

Each child is asked to bring a lunch, with a drink. Make sure everything is marked clearly with the child's name. If you send fruit that needs to be peeled or cut-up (apples, oranges), please pack it ready to eat. For toddlers and twos, please send finger food or sandwiches. Please make sure your child has been fed breakfast before arrival.

Illness:

Parents are asked not to bring sick children to school. For the protection of your child and other children, parents are requested not to bring a child who appears ill. Upon the recommendation of the Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the American Academy of Pediatrics, a child should not be taken from home when any of the following exists:

- a. Fever - currently or within previous 24 hours.
- b. Vomiting or diarrhea - within previous 24 hours.
- c. Any symptom of a childhood disease such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox or whooping cough.
- d. Common cold - from onset through one week.
- e. Green runny nose.
- f. Sore throat.
- g. Croup.
- h. Any unexplained rash.
- i. Any skin infection - boils, ringworm, impetigo, Pink eye or other eye infection.

Emergency:

In the event of an emergency, the parents will be notified immediately.

Clothing and Diapers:

Parents are asked to bring: 1) 4 disposable diapers, 2) a change of clothing - please label all clothing, 3) baby wipes, and 4) a bib for babies and toddlers. Please, **NO PULLUPS**. Make sure clothing is appropriate for play. For babies, let your little one wear clothing with snaps for easier diaper changes, if possible. Have your child dressed for the day when he arrives. Please do not ask the teacher to change him out of his pajamas. Children are not to bring toys from home unless it is a security item.



School Term and Inclement Weather:

Our School Term is essentially Labor Day to Memorial Day (September to May). We will announce using our Remind group texting app and through all of our class Remind groups information regarding closings and delays due to inclement weather. Pickens County Schools are a guide for us. We will follow their major holiday schedule.
